Tight twisty woods sections are connected by farmer's fields, access lanes, and gravel roads. A loop will be approximately 30 miles long, 20 miles off-road and 10 road miles open to both regular and farm traffic. There are logs to jump, creek beds to cross, rocks to navigate, and ravines to drop into and ride out of. Small displacement (0-500cc) dual sport and Enduro motorcycles with aggressive knobby tires are best.
